



As an educational charity, we aim to be accessible to all and spread the message of sustainability far and wide. We have created the 'Fair Share Fund' to provide a bursary, which we hope will overcome barriers that some schools face in coming here for a day visit. This will reduce our current cost of £11 per pupil by 80%, meaning a day visit will only cost £2.20 per pupil! Minimum charge of £44 applies, with a maximum capacity of 35 pupils per visit.

Eligibility

- All state-funded schools who have a percentage of children eligible for Free School Meals of **30%** or more, we use the "Get information about schools service" as our data source to confirm percentage of Free School Meals.
- It is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
